<b>Morning Journal</b>	<b>Sign In</b> - Have your child practice writing his/her name daily.
<b>10 min: Skill Practice LITERACY</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Letter of the week Hunt:</b></p> <p>Look for the letter <b>Mm</b> around your house.</p> <p>Check books, magazines, junk mail, ads, labels, etc.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>

<b>10 min: Project</b>	<p><b><u>Question of the Day</u></b> How do ants work together?</p> <p><b><u>To Do:</u></b></p> <p>*Watch: What's Inside an Ant Hill? <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=HedZXw_hAbs">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=HedZXw_hAbs</a></p> <p>*Talk about how ants work together in their colony. Do we work together at home? How?</p> <p><b>Torn Paper Ant Hill</b></p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>*Tear up brown or yellow construction paper and glue the torn paper on the blue paper to build an ant hill.</p> <p>*Tear the green construction paper to make some grass at the bottom of the paper.</p> <p>*Use red or black ink and make three fingerprints together to build the ants body.</p> <p>*Draw the eyes, legs, and antenna of the ants with a pen or fine marker.</p>

<p><b>10 min: Enrichment SOCIAL -EMOTIONAL</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Silly Simon</b></p>  <p>Play a follow the leader game with the rule: always do what you hear-NOT what you see.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Invite your child to join you in a new version of the game "Simon Says."</li> <li>- Explain the new rule: Always do what you hear, not what you see. Tell him that sometimes you will say and do the same thing, but at other times you will say one thing and do another.</li> <li>- Start slowly and pick up speed as the game progresses</li> </ul> <p>Make your actions match the words until the third or fourth direction. As you say Simon says stand on tip-toe, bend over instead.</p> <p>Continue to play, giving directions that contain all the action and space words your child knows: touch your nose, jump up and down, spin around, etc. BUT DO A DIFFERENT ACTION.</p> <p>Compliment him on his good listening skills when he catches you doing the wrong motion.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Let's read together!</b>  <b>Ruby the Copycat by Peggy Rathman</b>  <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hwHCHOUwQc">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hwHCHOUwQc</a></p>

<p><b>10 min: Specials</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art-Sarah</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Make a pattern rainbow.</li> <li>- You can draw or use shapes to create each line of the rainbow.</li> </ul>

<p><b>5 min: Skill Practice MATH</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Pots and Pans Band</u></b></p> <p>*Materials: pots, pans, wooden spoons, plastic spatulas</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Demonstrate how you can use the spoons or spatulas to tap on the pots and pans to make different sounds.</li> <li>2. Have child test out the pots and pans to see which sounds he/she likes the most</li> <li>3. Model different patterns and sounds including different rhythms and tempos</li> <li>4. Have the child copy your patterns.</li> <li>5. Challenge your child to make his/her own simple pattern.</li> </ol>
